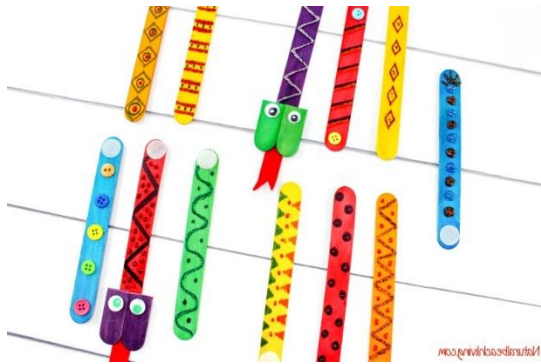

Did You Hear That? I'm Scared!

Super Fun Craft for ages 6-11

Mix-n-Match Snake Craft



What you need to make a
Mix-n-Match Snake:

Wooden Craft Sticks
Markers or Crayons
Glue (Glue Dots)
Red Felt Strip
Velcro Dots
Googly Eyes



Decorate all your craft sticks
with markers or crayons.

Arrange 4 or 5 craft sticks in the order
you want them for your snake's body.

Use Velcro dots and stick them to the
sticks on each end, either the top or the
bottom depending on how
you ordered your sticks.

For the snake's head, cut one stick into
thirds. Lay the end pieces side by side,
and glue the middle third to the back of
them so they are secured together.

*(We have done the cutting for you
and provided glue dots for this step)*

Using a glue dot, glue the red felt strip
to the back of the snake's head
for a tongue. Make sure the
"v" shape cut is pointing out.
Add googly eyes to
the top of the snakes's head!
