



## Ages 0-5




### **Life-Size Animals: An Illustrated Safari** by Rita Mabel Schiavo

Edward the giraffe has a problem, and his new friend, Cyrus, helps him.




### **Little Tigers** by Jo Weaver

Told through the eyes of a tiger and her two cubs, this beautiful book is a celebration of the love between parent and child, and the wonders of the natural world.


### **Interrupting Chicken and the Elephant of Surprise**

### **When You Trap a Tiger**




Jane Goodall fought tirelessly to protect the environment so that chimpanzees and other animals will continue have a place and a future on our planet.




### **Children of Blood and Bone**

### **Wild Life: Dispatches from a Childhood of Baboons and Button-Downs**


by Keena Roberts
